CYCU Selection Guidelines for Outstanding Teaching Assistants

Passed at 1st Academic Conference for 1st semester of the school year of 2009 on March 23, 2010 Amended at 1st Academic Conference for 2nd semester of the school year of 2021 on March 23, 2022

- 1. CYCU has established these guidelines to encourage outstanding teaching assistants, showcase their teaching enthusiasm, improve their teaching skills, and assist teachers in enhancing teaching quality.
- 2. The award recipients under these guidelines are teaching assistants of undergraduate courses who are recipients of CYCU Outstanding Student Scholarship for Graduate and Undergraduate Students.
- 3. The qualifications for outstanding teaching assistant candidates are as follows:
 - (1) Attend at least one CYCU teaching assistant training seminar or sharing session during the semester.
 - (2) Obtain a questionnaire score of 70 or above.
- 4. The selection of outstanding teaching assistant candidates will be made by each college, and each college must submit the recommendation meeting minutes and list. Each college may recommend outstanding teaching assistants, up to a limit of 2% of the total number of teaching assistants in the college.
- 5. The selection process will be conducted once per semester, and the awarded teaching assistants will be commended and awarded a certificate and a prize of NT\$3,000 at the teaching assistant training seminar or public occasion in the following semester.
- 6. Awarded teaching assistants should share their teaching experiences in relevant learning activities.
- 7. These guidelines will be implemented and revised following approval by the academic affairs meeting.
