

Chung Yuan Christian University's Regulations on the Separate Enrollment of Students with Excellent Athletics Performance

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Article 1

In order to cultivate sports talents and promote sports culture, our school has specially implemented the following provisions in accordance with Article 24 of the University Act, Article 19 of the University Act Enforcement Rules, and Article 19, Paragraph 1 of the "Regulations on the Advancement of Students with Excellent Sports Performance in Secondary Schools and Above" and The "Guidelines for the Review of University Admissions Regulations" stipulates the "Regulations on the Separate Admissions of Students with Excellent Athletic Performance at Chung Yuan Christian University" (hereinafter referred to as these regulations) to handle the separate admissions of students with excellent athletic performance.

Article 2

Our school has established an admissions committee in accordance with the "Criteria for the Establishment of Admissions Committees of Chung Yuan Christian University", drafted admissions guidelines, and handled admissions matters in accordance with the principles of fairness, justice, and openness.

Article 3

Anyone who has graduated from a public or registered private senior high school at home or abroad or meets the equivalent academic qualifications stipulated in Article 2 of the Ministry of Education's "Standards for Recognition of Equivalent Academic Qualifications for

University Admission" and meets one of the following sports performance qualifications may register to participate Admissions examination for students with excellent sports performance:

(1) Those who have the qualifications for screening and examination under the Ministry of Education's "Regulations on the Guidance of Secondary School Students with Excellent Sports Performance for Further Education" and have supporting documents.

(2) Those who have represented their country in international sports competitions and hold a certificate.

(3) Those who have participated in the National Games, National Games for All, National Secondary School Games, National Indigenous Games, or National Games for People with Disabilities and hold a certificate of such participation.

(IV) Those who have participated in sports leagues approved by the Sports Administration of the Ministry of Education or national single-sport championships organized by national single-sport associations and hold a certificate.

(5) Those who have served on a high school sports team for more than one year and have participated in sports competitions at the county or city level or above and have certificates and competition records.

(6) Those who have graduated from senior high school physical education classes and hold a certificate.

The candidate's sports performance qualifications in the preceding paragraph must be consistent with the sports event he/she is applying for.

Those who have been admitted through various admission channels of technical colleges or universities in the current year must submit a waiver statement from the original admission school before they can apply for admission in this round. Those who violate the above conditions will be disqualified from admission.

Article 4

The enrollment quotas listed in these regulations will be included in the school's total enrollment for the current academic year and will be submitted to the Ministry of Education for approval. After the enrollment, the vacancies will be returned to each department for the university's admissions allocation for the current academic year. After the admitted students report for registration, they are not allowed to apply for university admission in the current academic year. Otherwise, their admission qualification will be cancelled once discovered.

Article 5

The admissions brochure should list in detail the admissions program, department (group, degree program), length of study, number of admissions, eligibility criteria, examination items, examination dates, registration procedures, grading criteria, admission method, transfer principle, and comparison of scores with the same score. The order, registration procedures,

replacement regulations, score review, admission dispute resolution procedures and other relevant regulations should be announced at least 20 days before the application is accepted. Matters concerning the rights and interests of candidates should be clearly stated in the admission brochure and, if necessary, should be specially marked in bold or explained in detail with examples to remind candidates and avoid misunderstanding.

Article 6

This entrance examination is conducted in the second semester of each academic year as a separate admissions method in principle, and is limited to once per academic year. The quota shall not be divided into batches for admissions.

The admission examination items may be conducted in the form of written examination, interview, written review, practical or hands-on examination.

If the interview, practical or hands-on approach is adopted, it should be recorded in audio, video or detailed text. The written record should be completed before the Admissions Committee decides on the admission list. For those with exceptionally high or low scores, the score sheet should be noted. State the reason.

All examination and scoring data should be kept properly for one year. However, if an appeal is filed in accordance with the regulations, it should be kept until the end of the appeal procedure or the end of the administrative relief procedure.

Article 7

The Admissions Committee shall determine the minimum admission standard for each sport before the announcement of the results. Candidates with scores above this standard may register for distribution and selection of departments, and the priority order of registration and selection of departments for each sport shall be determined according to the total scores.

If there are two or more candidates who have registered and assigned to each sports department with the same total score, the order of admission will be determined according to the order of the same score stipulated in the admission brochure. If the total scores of the last candidate are the same and the order cannot be determined after taking the same score into consideration, they will be admitted together by adding quotas.

After the registered candidates within the enrollment quota of each sports program report for registration, if there are vacancies, the candidates who have registered for the department of each sports program can be assigned to fill the original enrollment quota in the order of priority before the deadline specified in the enrollment brochure; The deadline for making up the place shall not exceed the start date of classes specified in the school's calendar for the semester of the year of admission.

If the number of candidates whose scores meet the minimum admission standard of the registration department is less than the enrollment quota, they may submit the reasons to the

school-level admissions committee for approval and then admit the students who do not meet the quota.

The admission list should be officially announced after confirmation by the school-level admissions committee.

Article 8

Those who need to increase the number of admissions for this entrance examination should be submitted to the school-level admissions committee for decision, and the meeting minutes together with relevant supporting documents shall be handled in accordance with the following regulations:

(1) Applicants who are admitted as additional students with the same scores should report to the Ministry of Education within two weeks after the start date of classes in the school calendar for the semester of the year of admission.

(2) If the additional admissions are due to administrative negligence within the school, an admissions review report should be attached and the application can only be processed after being approved by the Ministry of Education within one month after the facts are confirmed.

Article 9

If candidates have doubts about their scores, they may apply for a score review within the time limit specified in the brochure. The score review is limited to recalculating the test paper scores and cumulative scores. Candidates are not allowed to apply for reading, photocopying, copying, photographing, re-marking, re-grading, Grading criteria, test answers, or information on the names of test setters, examiners, reviewers, and interviewers.

Candidates' scores may be reviewed only once.

Article 10

If a candidate believes that the decision made by the Admissions Committee of our school regarding him/her is inappropriate and has damaged his/her rights, he/she may file a written appeal to the Admissions Committee of our school within seven days from the day after he/she becomes aware of the decision. . Starting from the day after the appeal is accepted, the Admissions Committee shall make a formal reply to the candidate after making a resolution within one month. If necessary, a special task force shall be formed to conduct an impartial investigation and handle the case, and the appellant shall be informed of the administrative relief procedures.

Article 11

When handling examination affairs, the school shall be careful in setting questions, printing examination papers, making examination papers, marking examination papers, sealing examination papers, supervising examinations, calculating examination results, announcing

examination results, and registering students. Blood relatives or in-laws should take the initiative to avoid registering for the examination in the current academic year.

Participants have the obligation to keep the trial work confidential.

Article 12

When enrolling or registering, admitted students must submit certificates and supporting documents in accordance with the school's regulations.

If a student cheats in the entrance examination or the certificates and supporting documents submitted are forged, altered, forged, used by others, false, or do not meet the requirements of the application, the admission qualification of the student will be revoked if it is verified to be true. , those who have already enrolled will be expelled and no academic certificate will be issued. If the violation is discovered after graduation, in addition to ordering the cancellation of their degree certificates, their graduation qualifications will be revoked by public announcement.

Article 13

All revenue and expenditure related to enrollment operations shall be handled in accordance with accounting regulations.

Article 14

Any matters not covered in this regulation shall be handled in accordance with the admission brochure and relevant laws and regulations.

Article 15

This regulation shall be adopted by the Admissions Committee and reported to the Ministry of Education for approval before being promulgated and implemented, and the same shall apply to amendments.
