

Chung Yuan Christian University (CYCU)

Regulations on Inter-Collegiate Minor for Bachelor

January/19, 2018. Passed by the 2nd Academic Affairs Meeting, fall semester, Academic Year 2017-2018
July/19, 2023. Revised by the 2nd Academic Affairs Meeting, spring semester, Academic Year 2022-2023

- Article1 The Regulations Governing Cross-School Minor Studies for Undergraduate Students are regulated in accordance with Article 28 of the University Act, Article 25 of Enforcement Rules, and the school constitution of CYCU.
The departments hereof the Regulations include degree programs.
- Article2 Cross-school minor studies hereof refer to undergraduate students with CYCU and cooperating schools' consent to take different specialty of courses as minor departments at those schools which cooperate with CYCU.
- Article3 Those students from cooperating schools meeting the requirements of minor departments' recruitments shall apply within the stipulated time, the overdue will not be accepted. After being qualified as minoring, students shall select courses within the add and drop period of each semester in accordance with CYCU's regulations for cross-school course taking.
- Article4 The applicant's qualifications, study time, taken courses, credits, tuition fee standards, or the methods for those unable to study for some reasons shall comply with Minor Studies Regulations for Undergraduate Students of CYCU and the relevant regulations of cooperating schools.
- Article5 Students shall submit the relevant forms after completing the subjects, and credits and pass the grades stipulated by the inter-school minor departments. Those who have been reviewed by the two schools to meet the graduation requirements of the minor department of cooperating schools and the original school department should be listed on the degree certificate with the school and department's names of minor studies.
- Article6 Those students from cooperating schools shall pay credit fees in accordance with CYCU standard of tuition fees to select courses of minor departments at CYCU.
If students drop the minor, the fees will not be refunded.
- Article7 If students are unable to continue taking cross-school minor courses, students shall apply to drop the minor before the midterm exam. After the minor department of cooperating schools and the original school department consented, the original school department shall determine whether courses and credits taken for a dropped minor may be counted as elective credits for the major.
- Article8 The Guidelines shall take effect after they are approved at the Academic

Affairs Meeting and announced by the President. The same shall apply to all subsequent amendments.
