3. Overseas students may pay the housing deposit after moved in. If the payment is not completed within one week after moving in and is not paid after reminder, the student will be notified in writing for confirmation. Student will be disqualified from priority housing in the following academic year and will be listed as a written replacement for the bed.

★ **Route** CYCU Home Page → 新生1網通 → Undergraduate freshmen → Registration → Freshmen are exempted from the requirement to apply for leave of absence from school, or scan the QR Code.

### Important Regulations for Suspension of Study:

1. Leave of absence application is limited to one semester at a time and must be completed one month before the end of the current semester or before the start of the next semester. Failure to comply with this regulation may result in expulsion, as outlined in the CYCU Academic Policies.
2. Students applying for a leave of absence due to unforeseen circumstances must complete the leave of absence procedure before the start of semester examinations. Grades for the current semester will not be recorded, and the leave of absence period will not be included in the study period.
3. Students may apply for a leave of absence ranging from one semester to two academic years. However, periods of leave due to pregnancy, past pregnancy (including induced abortion, miscarriage, or childbirth), caring for children under three years of age, pregnancy of spouse or partner, or past pregnancy of spouse or partner (including induced abortion, miscarriage, or childbirth) are not counted toward the leave of absence period.
4. Students on leave of absence who enter military service must present a leave of absence certificate and proof of military service before the original resumption of studies date to apply for an extension of the leave of absence period. Upon completion of military service, they must apply for resumption of studies in accordance with the discharge order. Failure to apply for an extension of leave of absence will result in processing according to Articles 49 and 52. The period of military service is not included in the cumulative leave of absence period.
5. Upon resumption of studies, students must enroll in the academic year or semester corresponding to their original study program.

1. The system will automatically enroll Freshmen students in department-assigned compulsory courses.
2. Students must select General Education basic and elective courses through the Course Selection System by themselves.
3. Freshmen take 'English (I) & (II)' classes, which are mixed across departments and assigned based on their GSAT English scores; those who do not have GSAT or AST scores must take a placement test administered by the Language Center, which will notify the test time and location by email and phone.

1. Students who meet the English proficiency standards outlined in the university's "Regulations for English Course Exemption" may apply for exemption from required English courses.
2. To apply for exemption, students must submit valid supporting documents to the Language Center before the course withdrawal deadline of each semester.

★ **Route** CYCU Homepage → Academic Units → College of Humanities and Education → The Language Center → Regulation → Apply for English Course Exemption

★ Students who are approved for exemption are required to take alternative courses to make up the exempted credits. Whether these substitute courses may be counted toward graduation credits shall be determined in accordance with the regulations of the respective department or academic program.

1. Students who are unable to attend midterm, graduation, or final exams due to public duties,serious illness, bereavement, or other major accident, must apply for "Exam Leave" online.
2. After leaving approval, students must actively contact the respective course instructor for the make-up exam. The make-up exams will be held by the instructor and be restricted to only one chance per semester. Failure to attend the scheduled make-up examination will result in forfeiture of the opportunity for further make-up.
3. The principle is that those who have approved for make-up exams for graduation or the final exam shall complete the supplementary exam within 7 days after the end of the graduation examination week and 14 days after the end of the semester examination week.
