

Chung Yuan Christian University Regulations for Admissions to Post-Baccalaureate STEM Programs

Approved by the 26th Admissions Committee Meeting of Academic Year 111 on June 29, 2023

Ratified by the Ministry of Education under Document No. 1120066381, dated July 13, 2023

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Article 1

In order to provide students with cross-disciplinary learning opportunities and develop diversified professional capabilities, Chung Yuan Christian University (hereinafter referred to as the University) has established a post-baccalaureate program in the Department of Industrial and Systems Engineering and a post-baccalaureate program in Net Zero Circular Economics (hereinafter referred to as the Program). The "Zhongyuan Christian University STEM Field Post-Bachelor's Program Admissions Regulations" (hereinafter referred to as these Regulations) are formulated in accordance with Article 24 of the "University Act" and the "Guidelines for the Review of University Admissions Regulations".

Article 2

In accordance with the "Regulations on the Establishment of the Admissions Committee of Chung Yuan Christian University", our school has established an Admissions Committee (hereinafter referred to as this Committee) to formulate admission guidelines and handle admissions matters and emergency matters related to admissions in accordance with the principles of fairness, justice and openness.

Article 3

Special classes and quotas for enrollment must be reported to the Ministry of Education for approval before implementation.

Article 4

This special class is a separate enrollment program and may be scheduled for enrollment in spring and autumn. The enrollment qualifications are as follows:

1. For non-STEM graduates: Open primarily to ROC nationals.
2. For STEM graduates: Limited to the following academic fields (effective Spring Semester of Academic Year 113):
 - **051 Life Sciences:** which are 0511, 0512 and 0519, including biology and chemistry.

- **052 Environmental Sciences:** which includes subjects 0521, 0522 and 0529, including environmental science and wildlife studies.
 - **053 Physics, Chemistry, and Earth Sciences:** subject category 0532 Earth Sciences.
 - **054 Mathematics and Statistics:** which is categorized into 0541, 0542 and 0549, and includes Mathematics and Statistics.
 - **071 Engineering and Technology:** which includes 0712, 0713, 0716 and 0719, and includes Environmental Protection Science, Electricity and Energy, Motor Vehicles, Ships and Aircraft, etc.
 - **072 Manufacturing and Processing:** which includes 0721, 0723 and 0724, including food science, textile science, mining and refining, etc.
 - **073 Architecture and Construction:** which includes 0731, 0732 and 0739, including architecture and town planning, construction and civil engineering, etc.
3. Applicants with foreign academic credentials must comply with the "Regulations for Accreditation of Foreign Degrees," "Regulations for Accreditation of Degrees from Hong Kong and Macao," and "Regulations for Accreditation of Degrees from Mainland China."

Article 5

Enrollment method, enrollment class, duration of study, enrollment quota, application qualifications, registration procedures, examination items, score proportion (weight), enrollment schedule, admission principles, order of consideration for equal scores, registration matters, score review method, appeal method, The regulations on replacement, suspension of admission and other relevant matters such as the rights and obligations of candidates should be stated in the brochure and, after approval by the Association, should be announced at least twenty days before the acceptance of registration or application. This special class is an additional quota and admission is based on the quota approved by the Ministry of Education. If the actual number of registered people exceeds the enrollment quota, a special report must be submitted to the department for incremental adjustment.

Article 6

The admission method is mainly based on written examination. If necessary, interviews, written tests, practical or hands-on examinations may be added. These will be clearly listed in the admission brochure after approval by the Association.

Article 7

Admissions Principles:

The Association will calculate the total score of each project in accordance with the regulations. After the total score is calculated, the minimum admission standard for the Postgraduate Special Program of the Department of Industrial and Systems Engineering and the Postgraduate Special Program of Net Zero Circular Economics will be determined before the results are announced. Sequential admission. Candidates who meet the admission standards and are within the enrollment quota will be listed as regular admitted students, while the rest of the non-regular admitted students may be listed as reserve admitted students. If the number of candidates who have achieved the minimum admission standard is less than the number of places available for enrollment, they may submit the reasons to the Association for approval and the admission will be reduced to the number of places available. Applicants will receive a full refund of application fees available and they shall not be listed as reserve candidates.

If there are vacancies after the admitted students register, the reserve students may be used to fill the original enrollment quota specified in Article 3 before the deadline specified in the admission brochure; however, the filling deadline shall not exceed the start date of classes specified in the school calendar for the semester of the year of admission.

If there are two or more students who have the same total score as the last admitted student of the Postgraduate Special Program of the Department of Industrial and Systems Engineering and the Postgraduate Special Program of Net Zero Circular Economics, and if there are two or more students who have the same total score as the reserve candidates, the same score shall be determined according to the regulations of the prospectus. The order of comparison will be taken into consideration. If the results of the last item are the same after comparison or comparison of the same scores, the additional admission will be made and reported to the Ministry of Education for record within two weeks after the start date of classes specified in the school's calendar for the semester of the admission year.

Article 8

If the number of applicants for each enrollment department does not reach 20 after the application deadline, the class may stop enrolling for that academic year with the consent of the Association, and the registration fee will be refunded in full without interest. Candidates may not raise any objection.

Article 9

If candidates have any doubts about their scores, they should apply for a review within the time limit specified in the brochure. Applications submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.

Article 10

If a candidate has a dispute during the admissions examination, he/she may file a written complaint with the Association within one week after the results are released, in accordance with the "Admissions Examination Dispute Handling Procedures" of the school, and the Association shall give a formal reply within one month. A special case team should be formed to conduct an impartial investigation and handle the case, and the administrative relief procedures should be informed.

Article 11

The examination staff of our school have the obligation to keep the contents of examination work (including personal information) confidential. If they or their spouse or relatives of the third degree participate in the examination, they should take the initiative to avoid it.

Article 12

When handling examination affairs, the Association shall be careful in handling the processing of results, announcement of results, registration, etc., and shall abide by the principle of conflict of interest. If interviews, practical examinations, etc. are adopted, the process shall be recorded in audio, video or detailed text. For those whose scores are exceptionally high or low, the reasons should be stated in the score sheet.

Article 13

If any document submitted by the candidate is found to be forged, altered, forged, used by others, or false, the candidate who has not been admitted will be disqualified from admission; the candidate who has been admitted will be expelled from the school and will not be issued any certification documents related to the course; Graduates or dropouts shall surrender their degree certificates or completion certificates and shall bear legal responsibility.

Article 14

The relevant information of registered students should be retained for at least one year, but if an appeal is filed in accordance with regulations, it should be kept until the appeal procedure is completed.

Article 15

After the admitted students register and complete the course period, complete the required courses and credits, and pass the exams, they will be awarded a bachelor's degree and a degree certificate by the school. The words "Post-Bachelor's Degree Program" will be added to the bachelor's certificate.

Article 16

All revenue and expenditure of the Association shall be handled in accordance with accounting regulations.

Article 17

In addition to being handled in accordance with the admission brochure, other matters not covered here will be handled in accordance with relevant laws and regulations.

Article 18

This regulation shall be discussed and approved by this association and implemented after being submitted to the Ministry of Education for approval, and the same applies to amendments.
