# Chung Yuan Christian University (CYCU) Hourly Pay of Large-Scale Classes, Lectures Classes, and Summer School Regulations 

Passed by the 715th Administrative Meeting on Jan. 10, 1997 Amended in the 824th Administrative Meeting on May 4, 2006 Amended in the 881st Administrative Meeting on Dec. 2, 2010 Amended in the 990th Administrative Meeting on May 6, 2021 Amended in the 1006th Administrative Meeting on Nov. 3, 2022

Artical 1 The following system is the hourly pay of regular Large-Scale classes regulations, taking the form of 11 classes are as follows:

| Classes | Number of students | Benefit Payment <br> Standards |
| :--- | :--- | :---: |
| The First Class | Less than or equal to 70 people | Minimum Hourly Pay |
| The Second Class | $71 \sim 80$ people | Additional $15 \%$ |
| The Third Class | $81 \sim 90$ people | Additional $25 \%$ |
| The Fourth Class | $91 \sim 100$ people | Additional $35 \%$ |
| The Fifth Class | $101 \sim 110$ people | Additional $45 \%$ |
| The sixth Class | $111 \sim 120$ people | Additional $55 \%$ |
| The Seventh Class | $121 \sim 140$ people | Additional $65 \%$ |
| The Eighth Class | $141 \sim 160$ people | Additional $75 \%$ |
| The Ninth Class | $161 \sim 180$ people | Additional $85 \%$ |
| The Tenth Class | $181 \sim 200$ people | Additional $95 \%$ |
| The Eleventh Class | More than or equal to 201 people | Additional $100 \%$ |

Artical 2 The following system is the hourly pay of lectures Large-Scale classes regulations, taking the form of 8 classes are as follows:

| Classes | Number of students | Benefit Payment <br> Standards |
| :--- | :--- | :---: |
| The First Class | Less than or equal to 85 people | Minimum Hourly Pay |
| The Second Class | $86 \sim 100$ people | Additional $10 \%$ |
| The Third Class | $101 \sim 115$ people | Additional $15 \%$ |
| The Fourth Class | $116 \sim 130$ people | Additional $20 \%$ |
| The Fifth Class | $131 \sim 145$ people | Additional $25 \%$ |
| The Sixth Class | $146 \sim 175$ people | Additional $30 \%$ |
| The Seventh Class | $175 \sim 200$ people | Additional $35 \%$ |
| The Eighth Class | More than or equal to 201 people | Additional $40 \%$ |

Artical 3 In accordance with any of the following rules to handle the hourly pay for teachers in summer school.
I. The following system in accordance with the hourly pay of part-time teacher regulations, taking the form of 6 classes are as follows:

| Classes | Number of Students | Benefit Payment <br> Standards |
| :---: | :--- | :---: |
| The First Class | Less than or equal to 70 people | Minimum hourly pay with <br> additional $20 \%$ |
| The Second Class | $71 \sim 80$ people | Minimum hourly pay with <br> additional $38 \%$ |
| The Third Class | $81 \sim 90$ people | Minimum hourly pay with <br> additional $50 \%$ |
| The Fourth Class | $91 \sim 100$ people | Minimum hourly pay with <br> additional $62 \%$ |
| The Fifth Class | $101 \sim 120$ people | Minimum hourly pay with <br> additional $80 \%$ |
| The Sixth Class | More than or equal to 121 people | Minimum hourly pay with <br> additional $92 \%$ |

For each in-person class, ninety people are the maximum number of students. However, distance learning is not restricted by this rule. The size of the summer program shall not be less than 15 students. Distance learning of compulsory subjects is required for graduation or restudying, the number of students can be less than fifteen but not less than five people. The hourly pay for distance learning is in accordance with the proportion of students.
II. The full-time professor may choose the teaching hours of a course to be counted in the next semester.

In accordance with the Ministry of Education project subsidy, the hourly pay for the instructor is based on the regulation of the project.

Artical 4 The regulation shall be passed by the Administrative meeting, submitted to the President for approval, and then promulgated and implemented. Any amendments shall be processed accordingly.
