

Chung Yuan Christian University (CYCU) Regulations of Pre-Graduate

- Article 1 This Regulation is established in accordance with the University Act and the Degree Granting Act.
- Article 2 Juniors(Seniors for Department of Architecture and Department of Financial & Economic Law) applying for an immediate admission to a doctoral program should meet one of the following qualifications:
1. The student's past average grades should be within the first 75% of the department (or division) or the grade rank of the recent two semesters should be within the first 75%.
 2. The number of credits taken should be above 75% of the number of credits that needs to be taken.
 3. Has special performance proof that is approved and signed by the head of the department.
- Article 3 The applying students will obtain the qualification of pre-graduate once the application is reviewed and approved. The number of students accepted to be pre-graduate and the process of examination is decided by each department.
- Article 4 Students who have pre-graduate qualification that attend the postgraduate examination and register as a postgraduate that has a past average grade within first 30% can receive a scholarship of NT\$20000. The scholarship will be split in half and given to the student during each of their two semesters in their freshmen year.
- Article 5 Application process: Prepare the documents mentioned below and apply to Curriculum and Registration Division:
1. Application.
 2. Recommendation letter from the instructor or the head of the department.
 3. Past grading reports.
- After getting organized by the Curriculum and Registration Division, the applications will be sent to the designated department for examination and approval. Pre-graduates that attend the postgraduate entrance exam and get approved will not be restricted by the rule of credit transfer. (Graduate credits taken in college years cannot offset more than half of the needed credits in graduate school.)
- Article 6 In accordance with this regulation, the years of study for students attending the bachelor-master degree program should be at least 5 years. For the Department of Financial & Economic Law and the

Department of Architecture the years of study should be 6 years.

Article 7 Students that meet the requirements of graduation in both bachelor's degree and master's degree within the designated years of study will receive graduate certification for both bachelor's and master's degree.

Article 8 If foreign colleges that have collaboration with CYCU grant degrees to students then all of the above regulations will not be applied.

Article 9 Matters that this regulation did not cover will be covered by the CYCU Regulations.

Article 10 This regulation is approved with the School Meeting, reported to the principal then announced and applied. The same goes with modification of the regulation.
