

CYCU Application Guidelines for Pre-postgraduate Students (Preparatory Postgraduate)

I. Application Time: From March 29 to May 1, 2023

II. Application method: To apply online at <https://reurl.cc/6NaXEV>.

III. Eligibility:

Juniors (Seniors for the Department of Architecture and Department of Financial & Economic Law) applying for immediate admission to a Master's program should meet one of the following qualifications:

- A. Having an average GPA ranking within the top 75% of students in their grade (or group) or being in the top 75% of the class rankings for the two semesters prior to the application.
- B. Accumulating recognized credits equivalent to 75% or more of the required credits for graduation.
- C. Demonstrating special achievements that are deemed sufficient for approval by the department chair.

IV. Application eligibility criteria

- A. Those who pass the pre-graduate student review for two or more departments can only choose one department for pre-graduate studies, while the others are considered forfeited.
- B. Those who meet the graduation requirements for the current semester are not eligible to apply.

V. Required Documents:

By the "List of required documents for application by each department."

VI. Announcement of Lists:

The approved list announced on June 7, 2023, will be eligible for "Pre-Graduate Student" status in the next academic year.

VII. Scholarship Eligibility:

For those with Pre-Graduate Student status:

- (a) Students admitted through the school's master's program entrance examination in the next academic year, who complete registration in the same semester of admission and are currently enrolled, with a historical average GPA ranking in the top 30%, will receive a scholarship of NT\$20,000.
- (b) Students admitted and registered in the school's master's program in the next academic year, assigned a single advising professor by the school's

outstanding research faculty, and meeting the criteria of a historical average GPA ranking in the top 30% or showing research potential, recommended by the advising professor, will receive a scholarship of NT\$40,000.

VIII. Credit Exemption:

For those who pass the pre-graduate student application:

- (a) A maximum of 6 credits beyond the regular course limit for the next semester, specifically limited to courses offered by the Department of the intended master's degree.
- (b) Students who are admitted to the CYCU master's program through the entrance examination or general admission test for the following academic year should apply for credit exemption within the stipulated period after enrolling in the master's program. The credits earned during the undergraduate stage in the master's program courses are not subject to the limitation of being less than one-half of the exemption credits.
