Guidelines for Implementing Academic Ethics Education for Graduate Students

Passed at the 1st Academic Affairs Meeting of the 2nd Semester of the 109th Academic Year on March 17, 2021

1. Chung Yuan Christian University (hereinafter referred to as “CYCU”) hereby establishes these Guidelines to improve the quality of research ethics of students of master programs, in-service master programs and doctoral programs (hereinafter referred to as “Graduate Students”), in order to allow Graduate Students to be equipped with proper ethical awareness and attitude necessary for academic researches and related works.
2. Graduate students enrolled in or after the 110th academic year (including early admissions) shall complete the courses for graduate students (six hours in total) on the website of “Center for Taiwan Academic Research Ethics Education”, and shall also qualify the final examination and obtain the certificate of course completion.
3. The certificate of course completion described in the preceding paragraph shall be obtained before the application for the degree examination so as to apply for the degree examination.
4. Implementation method:
 - (1) The Office of Academic Affairs will upload the new student information of Graduate Students to the online platform of the “Center for Taiwan Academic Research Ethics Education” in each semester to assist in account creation.
 - (2) After Graduate Students complete the course and pass the final examination, they may then apply to download the certificate of course completion on the website.
5. These Guidelines are approved by the Academic Affairs meeting and reported to the President of CYCU for promulgation and implementation, and the same shall be applied to any amendments thereto.
