- Article 1 In order to promote internationalization, enhance students' abilities in English, and to encourages teachers to use English as a Medium of Instruction teach in English throughout the course, the English as a Medium of Instruction Award Regulation is specially formulated. (Hereinafter referred to as the regulation.)
- Article 2 The regulation applies to whom is qualified of EMI teachers in accordance with "Guidelines of English as a Medium of Instruction Teachers' Evaluation in CYCU".
  EMI course refers to the general course in each academic unit.
  The number of students should not be less than 15 in undergraduate courses and 5 in graduate courses.

Article 3 The application is divided into two types:

The first type: Applied by teacher in person.

The second type: Applied by the college or the department that has compiled all based courses and major courses of EMI for a year or a semester. The college or the department should apply with a group of courses. Each group of course should include at least 12 credits and give priority to undergraduate courses.

Article 4 The application is divided into two types:

The first type: Applied by teacher in person.

The second type: Applied by the college or the department that has compiled all based courses and major courses of EMI for a year or a semester. The college or the department should apply with a group of courses. Each group of course should include at least 12 credits and give priority to undergraduate courses.

To coordinate the school EMI policy the second type will be in priority.

- Article 5 All applicants should submit application form and the English syllabus which have passed by the curriculum committees of each college and department. The maximum of each teacher to apply this regulation is 2 courses per semester. The courses of International Program are not included.
- Article 6 English as a Medium of Instruction Award Regulation and other relevant issues should be approval at Meetings of Office of Academic Affairs.
- Article 7 Teachers will be rewarded according to the best results in the evaluation of "Guidelines of English as a Medium of Instruction Teachers' Evaluation in CYCU." The award amount is only applicable to undergraduate EMI courses. The relevant rights and obligations are as follows:

Article 8 For the awarded EMI teachers, if the teaching hour in English does not reach the prescribed ratio, the acquired reward shall be canceled and the fee for the deducted hours shall be deducted.

announced by the president in CYCU, and any amendments thereto.
